How do I get there?

From Mundubbera: Head south from Mundubbera on Mundubbera-Durong Rd for approx 50km and turn right into Monogorilby Rd.

Continue approx 20km to Monogorilby.

Turn left from Monogorilby Rd into Boundary Rd.

Go past Nolans Rd. Boundary Rd turns into McLaughlans Rd and comes to a T-intersection with Allies Creek Rd in approx 10km.

Turn left down Allies Creek Rd and head approx 500m to the paddock gate on the right. Look for the 'Field Day' and Burnett Mary Regional Group project signs.

From Durong: Head north from Durong towards Mundubbera on Mundubbera-Durong Rd for approx 60km and turn left into Monogorilby Rd.

(Follow instructions as above to Allies Creek Rd)
