Gympie Landcare will be launching our Cats Claw Action project for 2012 with a public hands-on workshop at the Six Mile Creek rest area on the Bruce Highway just south of Gympie. We have received some funding from the Commonwealth Government "Caring for our Country" program to assist groups of interested landholders coordinate efforts to control Cat's Claw in their local area. Gympie Landcare will be able to assist groups of interested landholders with direct on-ground technical advice and offer some financial assistance to these local groups to put this advice into action.

Gympie Regional Council and Nestlé are setting an example supporting a local project in the important remnant patch of lowland vine forest at the mouth of Six Mile Creek. The workshop will also see the launch of Gympie Landcare Cat's Claw Crusader information brochure which summarizes the current local best practice for planning and implementing mechanical, chemical and biological control of this destructive weed.
